On site you will get this :

1. **A nice main playing hall :** the chapel of collège Jean-de-Brébeuf located half-way between metro stations Université-de-Montréal and Côte-des-Neiges.



2. **Free parking** accessed through the main entrance 3200 Côte-Ste-Catherine.
3. **Special access for handicapped persons** (call 514.342.9342), elevator inside.
4. **Comfortable chairs, chess sets supplied ; chess clocks rented** 2 \$ per game + 20 \$ deposit or ID card.
5. **Cafeteria service.** A selection of hot and cold plates available Saturday and Sunday.
6. **An analysis room** to relax between rounds, review your games with friends etc.

1. In the playing hall, the top three games are displayed on screen. Observe the position instantly developing under your eyes while you watch the mimics and body language of the players fighting to stay on the podium or throw their opponent off it.

Lodging

On the south shore (Brossard) : excellent rates at *Motel Rideau* 450.466.2185 www.motelrideau.ca (50 \$ per night double occupation, 60 \$ quadruple). 25 minutes away from the Tournament Hall, according to MapQuest.

In Montréal : type « hotel de charme montreal » or « couette et cafe montreal » in your browser. You will discover affordable places (*Anne ma sœur Anne, Château L'Argoat, Couette et café Cherrier...*) at 80 \$ - 100 \$ per night single occupation, 90 \$ and more double occupation.

For a more luxurious accomodation : *Maritime Hotel* located downtown, next to metro station Lucien-Lallier. Ask for their special rate « Chess Championship » (109 \$ single occupation, 119 \$ double occupation).
